1 Declutter to make everything look more spacious.	2 Clean windows (inside and out).	3 Remove the scuff marks from walls (with magic eraser sponges).	4 Clean the tiles.	5 Use a grout pen for the grout in between the tiles.
6 Replace (or spray paint) old hardware like door handles or cabinet knobs.	7 Upgrade the light switch plates.	8 Power wash the driveway and walkways.	9 Clean the siding of the house.	10 Replace or update the house number.
11 Fix, paint, or replace the mailbox.	12 Clean and tidy the house (as much as you can).	13 	14 Make a list of anything small that needs fixing and DIY it.	15 Repaint the walls where you can/where it's needed.

26 Fix any squeaky doors or drawers with silicone spray.	27 Add more lamps to use in the evenings.	28 Use an air purifier and scent diffuser.	29 Set out a nice hand soap and soap dish in the bathroom.	30 Put on relaxing music in the background.
