Cheat Sheet



If they can't stop talking.

Continuous Story

Turns turns adding the next part of the story and see where it takes you.

If they fidget and can't sit still.

Charades

Act out a secret word or phrase through actions and mime. First to guess wins.

If they keep asking 'are we there yet'.

Countdown Game

Choose a high number and something to count down from the car window, like car colors, or signs.

If they love Geography.

License Plate Game

Spot license plates from as many states or countries as you can.

If they love English Language Arts.

Spelling Bee

Score points by correctly spelling words.

If they love Arts and Crafts.

Pictionary

Players secretly choose something to draw. First to guess wins. Use a pad and a pencil.

If they're great at hiding things in plain sight.

I Spy

'I spy with my little eye, something beginning with...'

If they often ask intrusive questions about your love life, routines, or appearance.

20 Questions

Choose a famous person or character. Players have to guess within 20 questions. Only yes/no answers.

If they critique what you put in their lunchbox like a Michelin inspector.

Going on a Picnic

The 'leader' must choose a secret rule. Other players figure out the rule by suggesting items to take. 'I'm going on a picnic and I'm taking...'

If their letter to Santa is always really long.

I Went To Market

Take turns repeating an expanding list of items. 'I went to the market and bought...'

If they're not very good at lying.

Truth or Lie

Say three things about yourself, two true and one made up. Players must guess the lie.

If they watch a lot of TV shows.

Name That Tune

Take turns humming songs or TV intros. First to guess wins a point.
